Two injured in North Wilkesboro fire

Two people were injured when their Peden Street, North Wilkesboro home, caught on fire Monday morning.

William Call, 54, and Linda Call, 61, suffered from burns and smoke inhalation from the fire that began around 7 a.m. They were taken to Wake Forest University Medical Center in Winston-Salem by ambulance.

North Wilkesboro Fire Chief Niki Hamby said their conditions were not immediately available at press time.

According to North Wilkesboro Fire Department officials, the fire is believed to have been caused by a dryer located in a utility room in the rear of the home. Officials said the house was damaged beyond repair.
